HELPS MORE LEE COUNTY ORGANIZATIONS

The Wildcat Run Charitable Foundation is providing monetary assistance to Human Trafficking Awareness Partnerships for the following ARTREACH programs. In each case, HTAP, teaches youngsters to recognize the signs and dangers of human trafficking using artwork as the medium. The focus of these programs will be conducted in the following locations for the next six months.

*PACE SCHOOLS FOR GIRLS, in Lee and Collier Counties, provides young girls and young women the opportunity for a better future through education, counseling and advocacy. The PACE model addresses the needs of girls and has garnered national recognition as one of the most effective programs in the country for keeping girls from entering the juvenile system.

* FOSTER GROUP HOMES FOR GIRLS which is part of "SOURCE OF LIGHT AND HOPE and UNITY CHURCH. This organization is a 501©(3) nonprofit whose mission is to promote the welfare of disadvantaged people, in this case the young, to meet their psychological needs, promote health, happiness and usefulness in life.

The cost for these programs and the associated material is \$7540. These programs will be held on Saturdays and/or after school as determined, with 5 sessions each, in approximately 4-5 different locations.
