Currently, Wings of Shelter has 3 Safe Houses licensed by the Florida Department of Children and Families (DCF) for girls rescued out of Human Trafficking.

Due to your generosity, we were able to pay for all the startup costs (Furniture, furnishing, decorations, etc) that must be done before we can obtain a license and take girls into the house.

We so appreciate your partnership and look forward to working with you in the future.

We did want to share a story about one of the girls that you helped. We'll call her JNI. You donated a piano keyboard to one of our houses, and she is currently taking lessons and really appreciating the opportunity.

JNI is 17 and came to us with a traumatic background. She came to us with great anxiety but is now improving every day. When she turns 18 in June 2018, she will have completed High School with honors and ready to start college. She will be able to go to a highly rated college in the state of Florida with her grades. She is currently enrolled in an SAT class in preparation to take her SAT test.

We are very proud of her progress and exceptionally grateful for the support of the wonderful residents of Wildcat Run.
